

ART IN THE PARK 2010

Saturday, April 17

Artists and artisans will showcase their talents at *Art in the Park 2010*, a festival highlighting the visual and performing arts in Columbia County. The festival will take place from 10 AM – 5 PM Saturday, April 17, at the Memorial Garden and Amphitheater adjacent to the Columbia County Library. This year's event will include performances by several local arts groups and performers, a variety of arts vendors, our second annual sidewalk chalk contest and lots of activities for the kids.

General Information – Exhibitor Entries

- *Art in the Park 2010* is to promote the arts in and around Columbia County, Ga. The festival will include fine art vendors, concessions, and performing arts, a sidewalk chalk contest, and children's activities.
- The location for *Art in the Park* is just off the primary north/south access, known as Washington Road (State Hwy 104).
- The festival will be held from 10:00 AM until 5:00 PM on Saturday, April 17, at the Memorial Garden & Amphitheater, adjacent to the Columbia County Library. Exhibitors are requested to have their booths set up and vehicles removed by 9:30 AM. Exhibitors may not take down their exhibits earlier than 5:00 PM. As space and access to the event is limited, safety of patrons and participants is the paramount concern of the event organizers. We ask that all activity err on the side of caution and courtesy during the event.
- The exhibitor space is 10' X 10' and costs \$35 per space (\$25 for Members of Columbia County Arts, Inc.). Exhibitors are responsible for their own display area. We do ask that your presentation be as professional as possible.
- There are a limited number of tents available for rent, with a fee of \$50 per tent on a first come, first served basis.
- Power is a limited resource. If you need power, please request this in your entry. Cost for power is \$10. This does not guarantee power will be available, so plans should be made accordingly.
- General Information:
- Location – The festival site is located near the Columbia County Government Complex, 630 Ronald Reagan Drive, just off Washington Road, and the Columbia County Library, 720 North Belair Road (The library is adjacent to the government complex) in Evans, Georgia. Evans is just to the north of Augusta and I-20. Primary access roads to get you to the event, aside from Washington Road, include the Belair Road and Riverwatch Parkway, both very distinguishable exits from I-20.
- Special Needs – the exhibitor's venue is handicapped accessible, but handicapped parking is limited near the access trails to the venue. Medical facilities are also located close by the venue.
